



Indian Coinages History Through Independent Princely States

PORBANDAR : Located on the Kathiawar Peninsular in Western India had Jethwa Rajputs as ruler's having ancient Rajput lineage. They were popularly called as "RANA'S" of Porbandar.

The coins of Porbandar are similar to coins of Kutch & Navanagar. They have a Nagari Inscription 'Shri Rana' on the coin. Monetary system are Trambhiyo, Dhinglo, Dokdo & Kori. Only copper & silver coins are found.

In 1807 Porbandar acceded to British Control and in February 1948 it became a part of Saurashtra State. No specific ruler's name is assigned on the coins.

RADHANPUR : Located on the Kathiawar Peninsula. The Nawabs of Radhanpur were Pathans of the Babi Family, who rose to the highest office in the service of Shah Jahan & Murad Baksh in Gujarat.

In early eighteenth century one of the family was appointed as Faujdar of Radhanpur. After Aurangzeb's death the state remained in control of the Babi Ruler's as a Maratha Jagir until 1820 when the State came under British protection.

All silver coins of Radhanpur appear to be Nazarana issues. Ruler's are Zorawar Khan & Bismilla Khan. The coins are strucked in the name of Queen Victoria & Empress Victoria.

The Monetary term are Paisa, Annas, Falus (50 & 100 falus). Copper Paise has 'Ji' inscripted on the coin in devanagari legends. The coins are Dump Uniface either in copper or bronze.

INDIAN COINAGES HISTORY THROUGH INDEPENDENT PRINCELY STATES

REWA : Located on eastern north-central India. The Ruler's of Rewa State where Bhagela/Vaghela Rajput's of the Solanki Clan who had probably migrated from Anhilwara Patan in about Eleventh Century.

Arriving in Bundelkhand they carved out for themselves a substantial kingdom which remained independent till 1597, when they were obliged to become Mughal tributaries under Akbar. In 1812 the Raja of Rewa Jai Singh Deo was forced under British Control.

In 1948 Rewa was merged into Vindhya Pradesh/Madhya Pradesh. Copper Paisa & Gold Mohur's are/were the Monetary attributes. Raghuraj Singh's Copper Paisa & 2 Paisa are strucked in the Name of "Agent Bushy Saheb".

INDIAN COINAGES HISTORY THROUGH INDEPENDENT PRINCELY STATES

KUTCH : State located in Northwest India, consisting of the peninsula north of the Gulf of Kutch. The Ruler's of the Kutch were the Jareja/Jadeja Rajput's, who came from Tatta in Sindh, they conquered Kutch in the 14th & 15th Centuries.

The Capital city BHUJ is founded in Mid-Sixteenth Century. The first coinage was struck in 1617 AD after Akbar's conquest & the fall of Gujarat Sultans.

Kutch remaines virtually independent through out the Mughal period as Rao Bharmal I visited Jahangir and established a warm relationship.

Due to internal conflicts, rival claimants and disorders in early 19th century Rao Bharmalji II was deposed & Rao Dasalji II was posted on the throne by the British Intrusion into the State Affairs. Rao Desalji II proved to be more amenable to the wishes of the Government, as he & his successor's ruled in the manner considered by the Britishers.

Maharao Khengarji III was created a Knight Grand Commander of the Indian Empire. After Independence Kutch came under the direct control of the Central Government of India.

In All the Present Gujarat State, Princely Kutch State and Baroda have finest coins, having different Ruler's Attribution. The Coin informs us about the British Ruler with both AD and VS inscripted on the Obv and Rev.

Kutch coinage culture starts from 1617 AD till Independence. The coins struck are in Copper, Silver and Gold. The coins are viz: 5 Kori, 2 1/2 Kori, Kori and 1/2 kori in crude as well as machine struck. The Purity of Silver in the coins are .937 and weight of the coin (i.e of 5 kori) 13.87 gms.

Copper coins are strucked in crude, semi machine struck and machine struck. Trambiyo, Dokdo/Dokda, Dhinglo, 1 1/2 Dokda, 3 Dokda are copper crude & semi machine struck coins while Adhio (Asia's biggest copper coin) Payalo, Dhinglo, Dhabu and Trambiyo are Regal issues milled coinages. During the reign of Madansinghji A Kutch Copper DHABU was minted on which "JAI HIND" in Hindi is inscribed. As it was struck on VS 2004/1947, it means 'Victory for Indian Independence'.

Similarly the Gold Koris, 50 kori's & 100 Kori's are strucked in the name of Pragmalji, Khengarji & Madansinghji. Madansinghji's Kori's have "JAI HIND' inscripted in Hindi on it. A silver "JAI HIND" 100 kori is also struck in the reign of Madansinghji.


At present H H Prithvirajji's family is residing in Kutch. A commemorative token of Queen Pritidevi in silver called 'Kutch Kori' is issued. The token is the continuation of Raja -Shahi issue in VS 2048 (1991) with legends JAI ASHAPURAMAA, the reigning diety of the Kutchi Jadeja Rulers.


